

# 1 TO 3 DAY TRIP FROM MARRAKECH TO MERZOUGA

Tips: Opt for a private driver to maximize time. Bring snacks, water, and warm clothing for the chilly desert night. This trip is fast-paced; consider a 2- or 3-day option for a more relaxed experience.

2-Day Trip: Desert Immersion

- Day 1:
  - Morning: Leave Marrakech early (6-7 AM) and drive through the High Atlas Mountains. Stop at Ait Benhaddou for a guided tour of the ancient mud-brick kasbah, featured in films like Gladiator.

  - Evening: Settle into a desert camp for a night of Berber hospitality, including a traditional dinner, drumming, and stargazing.
- Day 3:
  - Morning: Catch the sunrise over the dunes, followed by breakfast at the camp. Return to Merzouga and explore the town or visit a local Gnaoua music village for a cultural experience.
  - Afternoon: Begin the return journey, with a stop at Rissani's historic market or the Draa Valley's lush palm oases.
  - Evening: Arrive in Marrakech by 7-9 PM, with time to reflect on your desert adventure

# **6. STARGAZING IN THE SAHARA**



2-Day Trip: Desert Dash with Overnight Magic Overview: A 2-day trip from Fes to Merzouga balances adventure and relaxation, featuring a camel trek, desert camp stay, and cultural stops like Khamlia Village. With 7-8 hours of driving each way, it's fast-paced but allows an immersive Sahara night under the stars.
